- Silver Bulk Glitter 014902
- Crayola® Construction Paper 297945
- Black Wiggle Eyes 235101
- Decofoam Egg 315598
- Rick Rack Ribbon 356832
- Peony Pink Eco Friendly Paint 351098
- Light Blue Glitter Glue 351338



step-by-step

- Cover the Easter Bonnet in Kids PVA Glue. Sprinkle Purple Dust Glitter on the brim of the hat, Silver Glitter on the edge and Pink Dust Glitter on the top of the Easter Bonnet.
- To make the chicken, glue a large and small Pastel Pom Pom together. Cut a beak and feet from Crayola® Construction Paper and glue to the chicken. Glue on two Black Wiggle Eyes.
- Divide the Decofoam Egg in quarters and paint two alternate quarters with pink paint and two with blue glitter glue. Paste silver rick rack ribbon along the divides and around the centre tying a bow in the middle.
- Glue the chicken and the egg to the top of the Easter Bonnet.
- Decorate the front of the Easter Bonnet by attaching Foam Easter Stickers, Pastel Egg Sequins and Feathers.
