

To get started  
you will need...

- Quilling Paper 301564
- Quilling Tools 301572
- Kids PVA Glue 085746
- Cork Sheet 267088

## step-by-step

- **Green Head** - Using five strips of green Quilling Paper, glue the ends together with small dabs of glue, to form a long strip. Using a Quilling Tool, twirl into a tight circle, glue and leave it to dry.
- **Body** - Using two strips of green, place a dab of glue at on one end of the strip and stick together to form a long strip. Twirl and pinch to make a loose tear drop. Glue the end of the strip in place. When dry, pinch the top end at two sides of the rounded tear drop to make a space for the frogs head to rest. Glue the frogs head on.
- **Legs** - Using 1 strip of green, repeat the Body steps to make a rounded tear drop shape as pictured. When dry, attach this to the body with the pointed ends of tear drop facing down.
- **Back Feet** - Using two strips of green, place a dab of glue on one end of the strips to form a long strip. Twirl to make a loose tear drop and glue the end in place. When dry, pinch at 2 sides of the rounded tear drop to make the feet as pictured. Repeat for the other back foot. Glue and attach to body.
- **Front Feet** - Using one strip of green, twirl to make a tighter tear drop. Glue in place at the end. When dry, pinch at two sides of the rounded tear drop to make the feet as pictured. Repeat for the other front foot. Glue and attach on top of the back feet as pictured. When the Frog is assembled and dry, cut out a piece of cork and glue frog on to it.



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
