

To get started you will need...

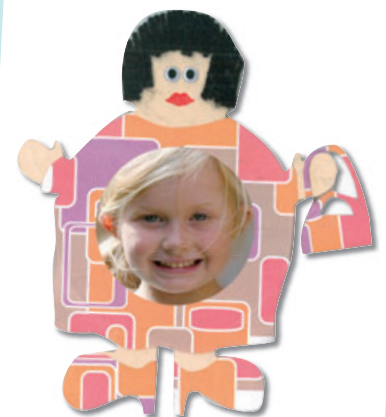
- Candle Wax Granules 339226
- Gedeo Candle Colourants 331082
- Gedeo Candle Perfume 331074
- Candle Wick 339234
- Paper Cups 260927
- Craft Sticks 001164
- Assorted Ribbon 324699
- Kids PVA Glue 085746



step-by-step

- ***This craft activity requires adult supervision.** Pour 3/4 cup Candle Wax Granules into a microwave safe dish. Cook on high until the Candle Wax Granules have melted and is of liquid consistency, stirring occasionally with a Craft Stick.
- Using a knife, flake off some of the desired colour of Gedeo Candle Colourants. Add the flakes to the melted Candle Wax Granules. Using a Craft Stick, stir until mixed.
- Add a few drops of the desired Gedeo Candle Perfume. Using a Craft Stick, stir until mixed.
- Cut a piece of Candle Wick, approximately 4cm longer than the desired height of your candle. Place the end of the wick in the bottom-centre of your Paper Cup. Hold it in place with a Craft Stick. Hold the other end of your Candle Wick up so that it does not become submerged in the liquid wax.

step-by-step

- Carefully pour the liquid wax into your Paper Cup. Remove the Craft Stick. Rest another Craft Stick horizontally, on top on the Paper Cup. Rest the top of your Candle Wick over the Craft Stick, ensuring that the wick stays in place.
- Once dry, tear off the Paper Cup to reveal your coloured candle! Cut one thick peice of Assorted Ribbon and one thin peice of Assorted Ribbon. Wrap around your candle and secure in place with Kids PVA Glue.
- Lastly, trim your Candle Wick to the desired length. Experiment with size, colour and scents. You may like to use Coloured Patty Pans to create different shaped candles.

***WARNING - Use extreme caution when handling hot wax. Hot wax will burn the skin.**
