

To get started
you will need...

- Christmas Craft Cones 235176
- White Crepe Paper 000968
- Kids PVA Glue 085746
- Decofoam Ball 137075
- Christmas Felt 088237
- Crayola® Super Tip Markers 113563
- Krystal Stems 341305



step-by-step

- Tear small pieces of crepe paper and glue them onto the cone covering it so that there is no cone visible.
- Spike a Decofoam Ball onto the point of the cone.
- Cut 1mm thick pieces of felt and glue them onto the Decofoam Ball as hair for the angel.
- Use a piece of Krystal Stem and bend them into the shape of wings. With the ends of the Krystal Stem spike them into the back of the cone to hold the wings in place.
- Cut a piece of Krystal Stem in half and use one half of the pipe cleaner to form a halo. Twist the pipe cleaner into a circle with a long stem. Poke the stem into the back of the decofoam head to make the halo.
- Draw eyes on the decofoam ball to make a face for the angel.
