

To get started
you will need...

- Crayola® Model Magic Coloured Class pack 003673
- Crayola® Washable Classic Markers 002899
- Crayola® Safety Scissors 213603



step-by-step

- Roll red model magic into a ball and then flatten the ball slightly making both ends flat.
- Mix a small amount of yellow, red into a white ball to form a peachy colour for the face. Make a small indent for the nose and form two blue eyes and a red smile. To form the hair roll a long thin snake shape and wrap around the head using White Model Magic.
- Make a flat circle from white Model Magic and snip with scissors to form points this will be Mrs Claus's collar. Place the in between the head and the body.
- Roll two lengths of red model magic in to snakes these will form the arms. Attach to the body.

- Form two hands with white model magic then attach the hands to the present and the present to the centre of Santa's body.
- To make Santa's boots first colour some white model magic using a black Crayola® Marker. Model the boots they are flat on the base so Santa can stand up.
