

To get started you will need...

- Coloured Cellophane 001149
- Oriental Decorative Paper 339176
- Curling Ribbon 260935
- Kids PVA Glue 085746
- Kindergarten Scissors 147553



step-by-step

- Draw a diamond shape onto the oriental decorative paper. Decorate the diamonds using other oriental decorative paper and gluing them on.
- Cut out a piece of cellophane in the shape of each triangle to place under the holes to form a kite. Glue the cellophane to the back of the paper.
- Cut 2 pieces of curling ribbon 1 metre long. Attach both pieces of ribbon to the bottom of the kite with glue. You may wish to decorate with a circle or diamond shape.

- Thread the curling ribbon through the back of one circle up through the first slit and then out through the top of the second slit.
- Continue to do this to all 6 circles. When you get to the last circle, make sure you glue the ribbon down to the circle so that all the other circles don't slide off.
