

To get started
you will need...

- Children's Hand Shapes, Pack of 100 (156752)
- Metallic Ripple Paper (136747)
- Kids PVA Glue (085746)
- Assorted Coloured Paper (189910)
- Sequins and Spangles (043133)
- Kindy Glitz, Pack of 5 (015537)
- Black Wiggle Eyes, Pack of 100 (235119)



step-by-step

- We covered a Children's Hand Shape 156752 in purple Metallic Ripple Paper 136747, attaching the two using Kids PVA Glue 085746.
- We then cut a set of lips for our fish from A4 Assorted Coloured Paper 189910.
- This was stuck to the back of the Children's Hand Shape using Kids PVA Glue 085746.
- We then glued leaf shaped Sequins and Spangles 043133 on to the hand to resemble fins.
- We also glued round Sequins and Spangles up the fingers of the hand as scales.
- To add some extra sparkle to your Handy Fish use Kindy Glitz 015537 to trace around your fish.
- Now, using Kids PVA Glue 085746, glue a Black Wiggle Eye 235119 to the face of your fish.

step-by-step

- Alternatively you could decorate you Handy Fish with:
 - Smiley Face Stickers 276063
 - Alphabet Discs - Black andd White 267054
 - Assorted Rhinestones 075929
 - Crepe Paper 192492
- Simply add a Self-Adhesive Magnet 088468 to the back of your Handy Fish to stick it to the fridge.
- Alternatively you could glue on a Brooch Back 088229 using Kids PVA Glue 085746.
- Now give your Handy Fish to Dad this Father's Day!
