

To get started you will need...

- Kids PVA Glue 085746
- Metallic Yarn 206987.
- Metallic Ripple Paper 136747
- Holiday Craft Paper 182121
- Christmas Pony Beads 205658
- Kindergarten Scissors 147553
- Jumbo Triangular HB Pencil 124404



step-by-step

- Draw a circle from a sheet of Holiday Craft Paper with diameter of 20cm. Cut out the circle and fold it in half, then unfold it and cut along the fold to make a semi circle.
- Draw 2 arms on one of the half-circles, cut them out and decorate. Using a different coloured piece of Holiday Craft Paper, cut out hands and attach to the arms with Kids PVA Glue.
- For the body, use the 2nd half of the circle. Use Kids PVA Glue to glue halfway along the straight edge. Bend the paper around into a cone shape and glue the straight edges together until they stick. Cut off the top of the cone to make a tiny hole.

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step-by-step

- Fold a piece of Metallic Ripple Paper in half and draw a wing which touches the fold and cut out. Draw hair on the other piece of paper and cut out.
- Draw a face, cut it out and glue it onto the hair shape with Kids PVA Glue.
- Cut a long piece of Metallic Yarn and fold it in half. Half way down the piece of Metallic Yarn, tie a knot to make a loop. Push the loop through the hole and out the top of the body.
- Use Kids PVA Glue to attach the arms onto the body and the hair onto the loop. Glue the face onto the hair piece. Glue on the wings.
- To make the shoes, thread Christmas Pony Beads onto the ends of the Metallic Yarn hanging from the body. Tie knots at the end of the Metallic Yarn to secure the Christmas Pony Beads in place.



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
