

To get started  
you will need...

- Prism Board 089573
- Red and Green Embossed Sequins 155804
- Silver and Gold Embossed Sequins 155812
- Glitter Stars 235390
- Christmas Sequins 136937
- Sequins and Spangles 043133
- Star Sequins 136887
- Coloured Glitter Stars 042937
- Embossed Sequins 236117
- Kindy Glitz 015537
- Tinsel Pipe Cleaners 003194
- Kids PVA Glue 085746



### step-by-step

- Cut three pieces of green Prism Board in half – giving you six pieces in total. Fold five of these pieces down the middle.
- On one piece of the folded card, draw half a Christmas tree and pot shape on one side. (see image 1)
- With the card folded, cut around the tree shape. Now you can use this tree as a template to continue to draw the trees on each of the folded pieces of card. Once cut, you should now have five trees.
- Cut the remaining sixth piece of card into five 4cm wide strips. Fold each of these strips in half (along their length) and glue half to the fold

## step-by-step

of each tree (see image 2).

- To decorate the tree we used Red and Green Embossed Sequins and Silver and Gold Embossed Sequins. You could also use Glitter Stars, Christmas Sequins, Sequins and Spangles, Star Sequins, Coloured Glitter Stars, Embossed Sequins, Kindy Glitz.
- Once dry, fold each tree in half and then each strip back onto it self (see image 3). Glue the trees together using the strip so they can open out into a fan.
- Join the first and last tree in the fan to create a freestanding shape with ten lines of branches.
- Now you can add Tinsel Pipe Cleaners around the tree for more decoration.
- To make the pot cut a 4cm wide strip of red Prism Board and glue the ends together - to place on the bottom of the tree.
- To make our shinning star we simply cut two star shapes from leftover Prism Board and glued them together with Kids PVA Glue. Place this on top of the tree!
