

To get started you will need...

- Metallic Yarn 206987
- Metallic Ripple Paper 136747
- Plastic Needle 016378
- Crayola Washable Markers 116087
- Kindergarten Scissors 147553



step-by-step

- Cut out 3 different sized (large, medium and small) circles using the Metallic Ripple Paper.
- Fold each circle in half, and then in half again. Unfold the circles, leaving you with quarter creases in each circle.
- Cut out a quarter from each circle. Fold each circle to make a cone shape and glue the edges together using Kids PVA Glue, to hold the cone in place.
- Cut slits the whole way around the bottom of the cone half way up to the top.

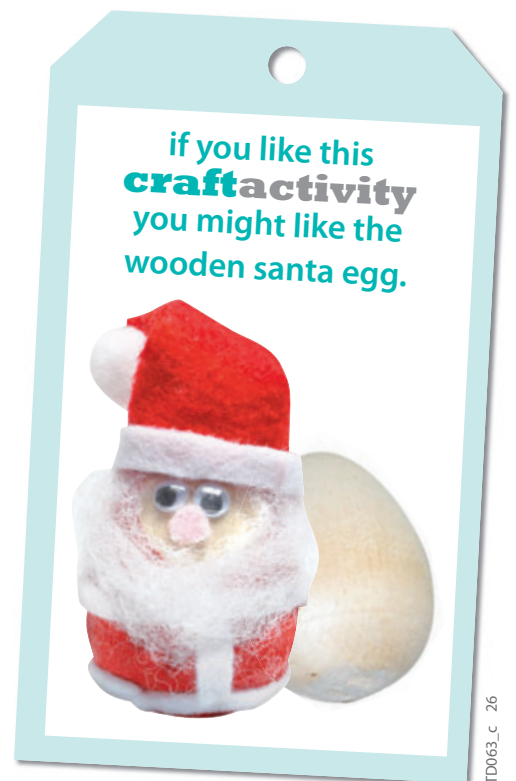


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step-by-step

- Using a Marker, curl each strand of cut paper around the Marker at the bottom of the cone up.
- Thread a piece of Metallic Yarn through the Plastic Needle and tie a knot in the end of it. Thread the needle from the bottom through to the top of the large cone.
- Tie another knot about 6cm up from the large cone and thread the medium cone the same way you did the large one. Do the same for the smallest cone.
- Now you have a Paper Christmas Tree to hang as a decoration. Try varying the size of the circles to make large and small decorations.



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
