

To get started you will need...

- Paper Plates 009902
- Liquicryl Burnt Sienna 227967
- Brown Crepe Paper 096859
- Kids PVA Glue 085746
- Acrylic Felt Sheets 012443
- Kindy Glitz 015537
- Foam Sheets 089441
- Large Black Wiggle Eyes 235119
- Christmas Glitter Pom Poms 042838
- Christmas Bells 042549
- Red Satin Ribbon 205211 or Green Satin Ribbon 205229
- Kindergarten Scissors 147553



step-by-step

- Paint the Paper Plates whichever colour you would like the Reindeer's face to be. You could paint yours brown using burnt sienna from the Liquicryl Paint Set.
- To create fur cut strips of Brown Crepe Paper and glue onto the plate using Kids PVA Glue.
- For antlers, hair and ears use Acrylic Felt Sheets. Cut out the desired shape you would like and then glue these on. We outlined ours with Kindy Glitz to add some sparkle.
- To finish off the ears we used a piece of pink Foam Sheet. Cut out the

step-by-step

same shape as the ears – but a little bit smaller – and glue on.

- Add Santa's eyes using Large Black Wiggle Eyes.
- For his nose and rosy cheeks attach Christmas Glitter Pom Poms.
- Create the mouth we used black Acrylic Felt Sheets. Cut out the desired shape you would like and then glue this on.
- As a finishing touch thread a Christmas Bell onto a ribbon. We suggest Red Satin Ribbon or Green Satin Ribbon. Tie this into a bow and then glue onto the bottom of your plate.
- Now you have your very own Paper Plate Reindeer!
