

To get started you will need...

- Hygienic Craft Rolls 214783
- Micador Metal Trimmer 301432
- Kindergarten Scissors 147553
- Green Liquicryl 5 Litre 227975
- Metallic Ripple Paper 136747
- Kids PVA Glue 085746
- Christmas Glitter Pom Poms 042838
- Tinsel String 042929
- Jumbo Triangular HB Pencil 124404
- Ruler 30cm 110551



step-by-step

- Cut 7 Hygienic Craft Rolls in two. Measure each one using a Ruler and draw a line around the centre. You can cut them using a pair of Scissors or a Micador Metal Trimmer. If you use the Metal Trimmer make sure an adult is helping you.
- Paint 12 of these Hygienic Craft Rolls using Liquicryl Green Paint and leave to dry.
- Cover the last two Hygienic Craft Rolls in silver Metallic Ripple Paper using Kids PVA Glue. We used these to make the stand for the Christmas Tree.
- Start by gluing four green Hygienic Craft Rolls together along-side each

other using Kids PVA Glue. Next form the second row attaching three green Hygienic Craft Rolls in the centre of the joins of the previous joined four. Attach two green Hygienic Craft Rolls and then place the last one on top.

- Next, we attached the two silver rolls together using Kids PVA Glue, to form the base shape of a tree. Secure a green Hygienic Craft Roll on top with Kids PVA Glue. Then glue another green roll directly on top of this. This is the stand. Glue the stand and tree together using Kids PVA Glue.
- To decorate the tree cut a star shape from silver Metallic Ripple Paper and attach this to the tree using Kids PVA Glue. Next glue Christmas Glitter Pom Poms in the centre of the Hygienic Craft Rolls and wrap Tinsel String around the tree.
- Now you have a decorative Rollie Christmas Tree.
