

To get started you will need...

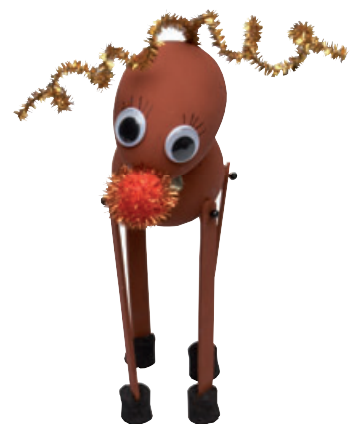
- Wooden Bead Dolls 260364
- Liquicryl Paint Set 286997
- Crayola® Washable Markers 058289
- Small Black Wiggle Eyes 235101
- Christmas Pony Beads 205658
- Kids PVA Glue 085746
- Tinsel Pipe Cleaners 003194
- Mini Metallic Patty Pans 205203
- Embossed Sequins 236117
- Metallic Yarn 206987



step-by-step

- To make these cute wooden Angels we used Wooden Bead Dolls.
- First paint your wooden doll whichever colour you would like using the Liquicryl Paint Set. Alternatively you could colour it in with markers such as Crayola® Washable Markers.
- Once dry, you can draw on your Angel's face using Crayola® Washable Markers. For eyes you could also use Small Black Wiggle Eyes.
- Add cute hair buns by gluing Christmas Pony Beads to the side of the dolls head with Kids PVA Glue.

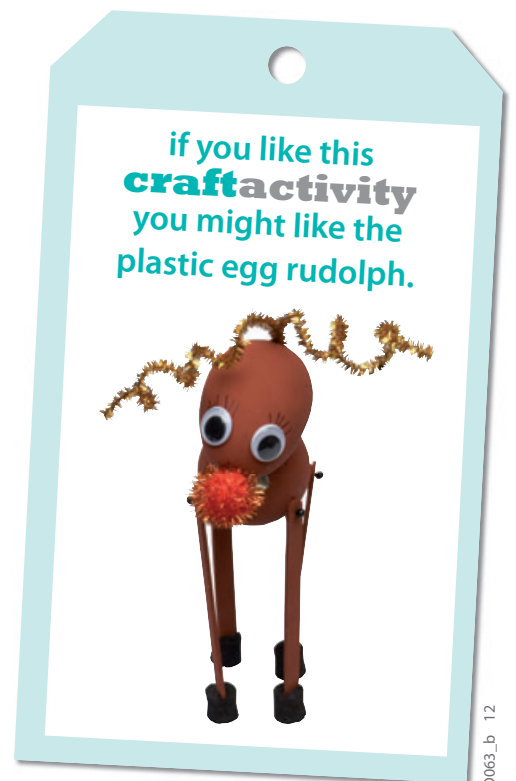

step-by-step

- Bend a Tinsel Pipe Cleaner into a halo shape and stick onto the doll using Kids PVA Glue.
- Add wings by gluing Mini Metallic Patty Pans to the side of the doll.
- Then add some sparkle... using Embossed Sequins.
- If you want to use your Angel as an ornament simply stick some Metallic Yarn on the back of your doll using Kids PVA Glue.
- Your Christmas Wooden Bead Angel is now complete!
