

## To get started you will need...

- Wooden Eggs 228346
- Red Liquicryl Paint 228007
- Wadding 182550
- Christmas Felt 088237
- Pom Poms 000034
- Kids PVA Glue 085746
- Black Wiggle Eyes 235119
- Round Stubby Brush Minor 009712
- Kindergarten Scissors 147553



## step-by-step

- Paint a Wooden Egg with Red Liquicryl Paint, leaving a circle of unpainted wood for Santa's face.
- Once dry, cut 2 x 1 cm thick strips of white Christmas Felt. Wrap one piece around the centre of the Wooden Egg. Cut off any excess Christmas Felt and glue in place.
- Wind your second piece of Christmas Felt 2/3rd of the way down your Wooden Egg to make the bottom of Santa's jacket. Cut off any excess Christmas Felt and secure in place with glue.
- Glue the remainder of your Christmas Felt strip vertically down the front of Santa's Jacket.

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### step-by-step

- Thin out a piece of Wadding by stretching it out. Wrap it around the unpainted circle of your Wooden Egg and secure in place with glue.
- Cut a triangle of red Christmas Felt. Glue the base of your triangle to the top of Santa's head.
- Glue the sides of the triangle together at the back of the head to create a cone. Fold the cone to the back of Santa's head, add a white Pom Pom and secure in place with Kids PVA Glue.
- Wrap the remainder of your white Christmas Felt strip around the base of Santa's hat and glue in place.
- Cut out a small nose from your Christmas Felt and glue it and 2 Black Wiggle Eyes to Santa's face.



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
